Next Tuesday begins our Toronto Public Health (T.P.H.) dental program for all students from Junior Kindergarten to Grade 8. The dental program helps to identify children with oral health problems, a screening program and is offered to students in accordance with the Ontario Ministry of Health requirements for mandatory health programs. The dental hygienist will assess the need for topical fluoride, scaling, sealant and any other obvious dental needs.

As a follow up to the screening, only parents whose children are identified as requiring dental services will be notified. A note to that effect will be sent home with your child/ren for your information and action. You may also receive a phone call from T.P.H. dental staff to assist you in accessing care.

If you do not wish your child/ren to be screened, please inform Celia in the office by Tuesday December 5th in the AM. Thanks so much for your support.
